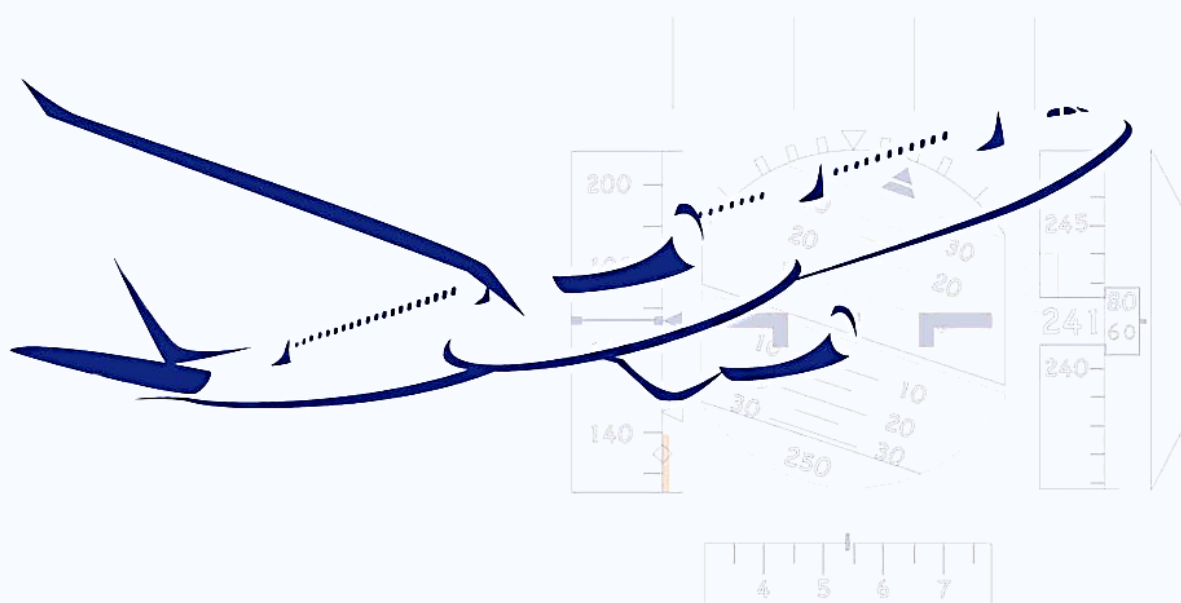


# TRI/SFI

## Objective

The TRI/SFI course is an intense course!

The course content meets all the applicable FCL regulations and is common to TRI's and SFI's. The course has been designed for experienced pilots having extensive experience and knowledge of the aircraft they want to instruct.

The course objective is to give you the necessary theoretical knowledge and practical skills to efficiently teach your students. It is essential that candidates demonstrate a high level of teaching skills during this short and yet intensive course.

CRM is a vital aspect of the course and our experienced TRI will share with you their experiences and methods for efficient training.

## Entry Requirements:

- Valid Type Rating on A320; A330; A340; B747 or B717;
- Hold a Core Course Certificate or hold/have held an instructor rating (including Line Training Commander certificate issued by a recognized airline);
- Valid Class 1 Medical Certificate;
- ICAO English level 4.

## Ground Training

- The teaching techniques;
- The simulator specifics;
- Crew resource Management for Instruction;
- Etc.

*Ground Training duration 03 days – 24 hours*

## Simulator Training

- Full flight simulator ( minimum) 03 sessions - 09 hours;
- Full flight simulator panel instructions 01 sessions - 04 hours;
- Right Hand seat training session 01 sessions - 02 hours;
- Final TRI/SFI supervised test. Will be supervised by a Civil Aviation Designated Instructor.

*Flight Training duration 06 days – 17 hours minimum*

## Aircraft Training Only TRI's

Base Training is up to proficiency and will consist in the following minimums:

- 4 Take off's;
- 4 Landings

TRI candidates not attending the aircraft Training will be issued with “sim only TRI rating”

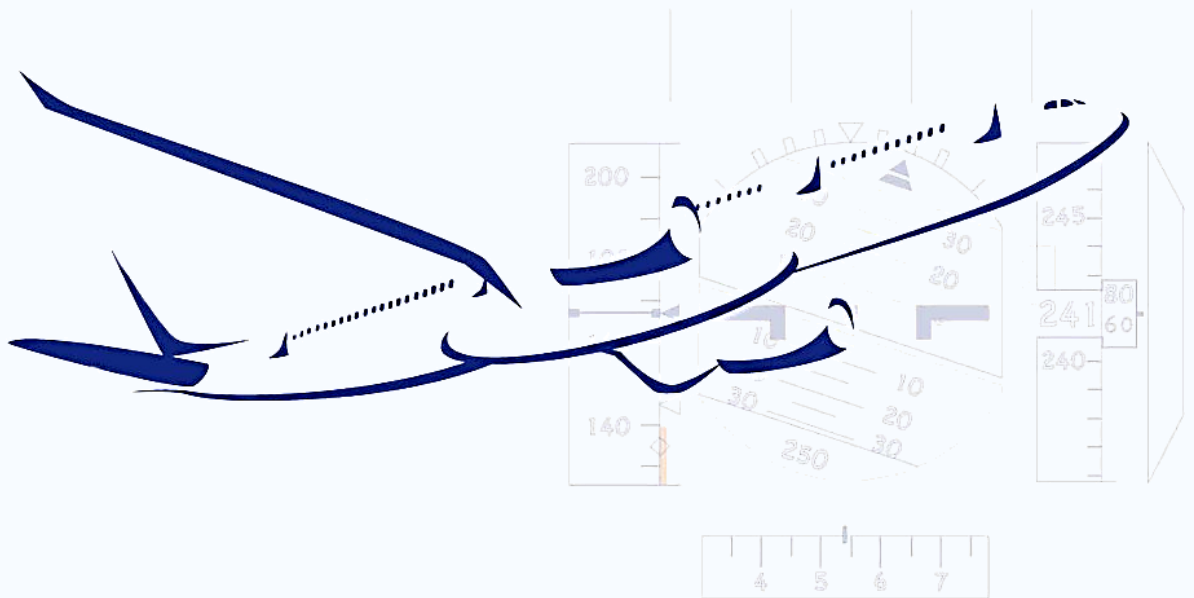
## Training Material
